INTERLOCKING SYSTEM

WINNER SUSTAINABILITY

Interlocking System is a modular desk system without mechanical joints, made from sustainably sourced Italian poplar from sustainable cultivation.

These features earned it the 'Sustainability' award at the Archiproducts Design Award 2024.

The system has only three elements:

- Bridge leg
- Half shelf
- Beam

Thanks to a simple interlocking system between these components, Interlocking offers a flexible configuration that allows you to create from a basic configuration with two face-to-face workstations to the creation of multi-workstation meeting tables.





MOBI

Designer: S. Mauri - CUF Milano Lab

Mobi is a reconfigurable system intended for work areas.

These areas do not have a specific function.

It is suitable for creating individual workstations, desks and tables.

It is possible to create linear or horseshoe-shaped meetings, depending on specific requirements.

The elements that make it up are:

- 160x80 desk with folding legs;
- trolley for transporting the desks, which can be transformed into a shelf if required.
- various accessories that complete the series and transform it into a shelf.
- various accessories that complete the series.

Furthermore, the creation of different configurations is facilitated by the presence of magnets on both the desks and trolley structure that allow the elements to be placed side by side easily.





JALEED

Jaleed, which means 'ice' in Arabic, evokes the image of a brilliant, fluid and crystalline element just like the glass wall that bears the same name.


It is the perfect combination of lightness and solidity, creating an ideal balance between aesthetics and functionality.

It is the result of years of mechanical research and acoustic experimentation, Jaleed is a sophisticated yet robust and highly soundproof wall.

Jaleed has obtained soundproofing certifications that distinguish it from its competitors in the market:

- Double-glazed wall: 49 dB certified sound insulation.
- Door: certified sound insulation of 42 dB.

These features ensure excellent acoustic insulation, making Jaleed the perfect solution for environments that require both aesthetic quality and superior acoustic comfort.

Diva is a modular upholstery system distinguished by great versatility, offering a wide range of shapes and configurations, combining comfort and aesthetics.

Thanks to its modular structure, Diva can be easily adapted to different environments, from offices to resting lounge areas. It can be installed in a variety of environments, either to create resting lounge areas in offices or to organise more informal workstations.

In addition, it is equipped with mobile and fixed tables and options of electrification options, making it even more attractive andfunctional for various work and socialising needs.

A further advantage of the system is its sound-absorbing backrests that make it possible to create private and cosy environments, ideal both for isolating oneself during work and for moments of relaxation.





BA FOCUS

A Focus is the ideal phone booth for open-plan offices, designed to provide certified acoustic privacy and improve productivity. Available in 1 or 4-seater versions, it is perfect for phone calls or short meetings.

The acoustic certification ensures clear and confidential conversations, while the versatile configurations allow you to choose between 1-seater for individual work and 4-seater for small teams.


The compact, modern design includes integrated ventilation and lighting, creating a comfortable environment.

The modularity of the structure allows Lambrate to be adapted to various environments, both workspaces and residential settings, enabling the creation of custom configurations.





BOLD

MICASA



Ideal for informal meetings, private conversations, phone calls, or simply a coffee break, it is the perfect place to isolate yourself and maintain focus.


With an internal area of 120x200 cm and a height ranging from 170 to 230 cm, MIcasa is compact yet comfortable.


CONCEPT

Fusion allows the integration of attachable accessories, enhancing both the functionality and aesthetics of the workstations.

These customizations highlight the versatility of the Fusion system, enriching the workspace with unique and perfectly coordinated elements.



HUMAN TECHNOPOLE

HUMAN TECHNOPOLE (MIND District, Milan, 2022-2023)

The Human Technopole project involved the redevelopment and renovation of the entire Italian Pavilion at Expo Milano 2015, Palazzo "ITALIA", creating over 400 workstations. For this major project, the following product lines were used:

· Fusion:

Implemented in operational areas, providing individual workstations, bench desks, and coworking spaces.

· Bramante:

Designed for executive areas, featuring a more refined aesthetic while maintaining perfect harmony with the overall environment.











GLS group

GLS Headquarters, Milan



DESIGNER: Arch. Paolo Turconi (Centrufficio)

The renovation of GLS headquarters transformed the workspaces into environments designed to enhance employee well-being and boost productivity.

· Entrance:

A spacious and bright area, divided into a reception zone and lounge areas featuring sofas and poufs, interspersed with Phone Booths.

The space is further enriched with MiCasa and Fusion Outdoor, creating hybrid areas suitable for both work and relaxation.

\cdot Operational and Executive Offices:

Furnished with Bramante desks (single for executives, bench-style for operational workstations) and Isola Up height-adjustable desks. Tetrix acoustic panels optimize sound quality, ensuring a comfortable work environment.

· Cafeteria and Break Area:

The cafeteria features colorful seating, creating a lively atmosphere, while the break area offers a relaxation space with a custom 8-player foosball table branded with the company's logo.











POLI - HUB

Polihub Startap District & Incubator, Milano


For Polihub, Centrufficio managed the design, acoustic study, production, and installation of a sound-absorbing panel system, aimed at enhancing acoustic comfort in common areas, open spaces, and private offices.

Specifically, Tetrix panels were installed using different methods:

- Wall suspension
- Free-standing configuration
- Wall-mounted application (Tetrix Game)

These interventions not only improved the acoustics but also created a harmonious aesthetic impact within the spaces.





PROGETTO CMR

Uffici Progetto CMR, Milano



The furnishings were designed using Seventy-Seven bench desks, developed in collaboration with Progetto CMR.

The storage units were replaced with Cartesio lockers, offering various solutions for:

- Wardrobe spaces
- Archiving and storage
- · Open display areas
- Planters

The Seventy-Seven bench desks, characterized by extremely geometric and minimalist lines, are enhanced with a central metal shelf that can be used to hold acoustic panels, support monitor placamento, store office accessories.

The project involved the renovation of four distinct areas: the break area, meeting rooms, training rooms, and an outdoor space.

Centrufficio managed every aspect, from design to furniture supply, providing comprehensive solutions for each space, including:

- Furniture and seating
- Equipped and retractable partition walls
- Roller blinds and preserved greenery
- · Kitchens, pergolas, flooring, and carpets

Additionally, custom-made woodworking elements were supplied, such as decorative vertical slats and bespoke furniture, tailored to meet the project's specific requirements.
